1. Theory examination will be conducted **online on MS Teams**.

4. The first question in the paper will deal with student's details, such as, **Full Name. The second question will be PRN of the student.** These questions, obviously will carry no marks and are compulsory.

Specific instructions to be followed by students, while using the MS Teams platform are given below:

Before beginning of the exam:

- 1. Students must make sure that they have a good internet connection. An alternate arrangement of network (Wi-Fi or data connection) should be kept ready for use, in case the need arises. This is a must during the entire duration of the examination, till the submission of the final response.
- 2. Install Microsoft Teams App, preferably the desktop version on at least two devices (Laptop/Desktop and Mobile Phone).
- 3. Keep the Username and Password to be used, in case, if it is required during the login.
- 4. In case of any connectivity issue, log-out of MS Teams and then login back again.
- 5. Students should login at least 15 minutes prior to the commencement of the examination.
- 6. Responses submitted without joining the meeting will not be considered as valid responses. In such cases, students will be considered absent and the answer sheet will not be assessed further. During the exam:
- 1. Do not click the "Back" button on the browser, while using the web app version. This will take the user out of the test and prevent MS Teams from tracking the selected answers.
- 2. Click the "**Submit / Turn In**" button to submit the answers. Do not press "Enter" on the keyboard to submit the answers.
- 3. Save the test using the "Save" button periodically during the examination.
- 4. Question paper will be assigned through MS Teams.
- 5. The examination will start as mentioned in the timetable.
- 6. All the students are expected to keep their **video cameras ON** and **UNMUTE their microphone** during the exam. (Students will be supervised upon by the supervisors during the examination).
- 7. Click the "Submit / Turn In" button, when ready to submit the answers.
- 8. Students are not allowed to use headsets during the exam.
- 9. Answer sheet to be uploaded must have nomenclature as
