#### **1. Confirmation of Minutes and Action taken on Previous Meeting**

- a. Confirmation of Minutes: Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 11<sup>th</sup> March 2024 were confirmed.
- b. Action taken on Minutes: It was reported by the Chair, that the recommendations of the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) were placed in the Governing Body meeting, which accepted the same with minor modifications are as follows:

<b>A</b>	To organize training sessions for teaching faculty in emerging engineering domains, including Artificial Intelligence (AI), Machine Learning (ML), Data Science (DS), High-Performance Computing, Industry 4.0, and 3D Printing. This initiative aims to equip faculty with the latest knowledge and skills, ensuring alignment with current industry trends and enhancing the quality of education provided to students.	Faculty training programs have been identified, and staff members are encouraged to enroll in Quality Improvement Programs (QIP). Financial assistance will be provided to support their participation, with the goal of enhancing teaching skills and staying updated with the latest advancements in their respective fields.
<b>B</b>	To improve the effectiveness and efficiency of the online evaluation system for better transparency and accuracy in assessment.	Training sessions on QBMS and the online evaluation module were organized for staff members.



C	To organize both social and technical events that raise student awareness about pressing social issues. These events will encourage students to think innovatively and explore possible solutions, fostering a sense of responsibility and creativity in addressing societal challenges.	Students were motivated to participate in Hackathon=24 and similar competitions. Events like Jal Gaguri Saptah were conducted at the local level.
D	Encourage both staff and students to actively engage in sports and fitness activities to promote overall well-being. Regular participation in these activities will help improve physical health, mental clarity, and foster a spirit of teamwork and discipline.	Staff and students are motivated to participate in physical activities. Also free health checkups for women faculties, yoga sessions were conducted.
E	To identify and apply for relevant national and international indexing, rankings, and awards to enhance the institute's reputation and visibility.	Applications for rankings, such as the Week-Hansa Research Survey and IIRF Rankings, were submitted, yielding satisfactory results.

- To reform Continuous Assessment (CA) components that emphasize on integrating practical and innovation-based evaluations to enhance student skill development, overall growth, and placement readiness.

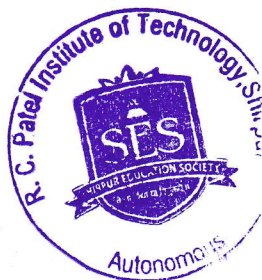
