Agenda – 9: - Any other matter with the permission of the Chair.

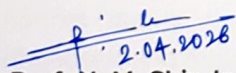
With the permission of the Chair, the President emphasized timely execution of planned activities, proper documentation, and submission of reports to ensure effective implementation of IIC initiatives.
