

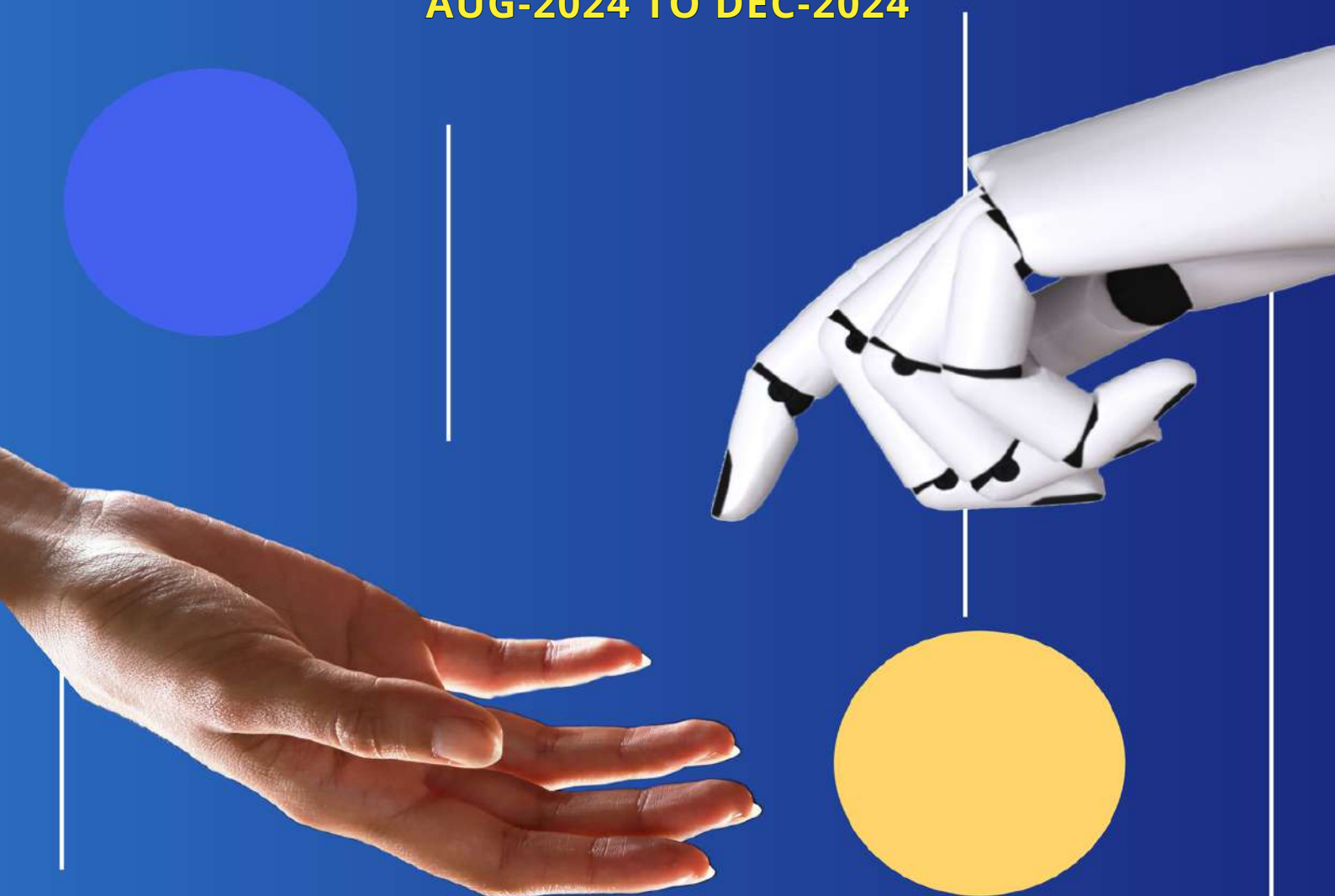

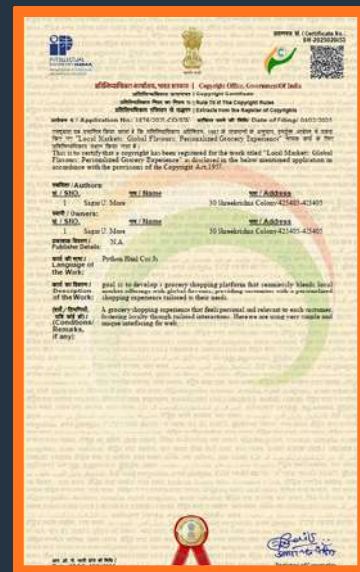

Smart India Hackathon 2024

The Department of Computer Engineering successfully organized the **Internal Smart India Hackathon 2024** at R. C. Patel Institute of Technology, Shirpur, on **2nd and 5th September 2024**. The event aimed to encourage innovation, problem-solving abilities, and teamwork among students by providing a platform to present impactful ideas and working prototypes.

The competition was conducted in two rounds. **Round I, held on 2nd September 2024**, focused on idea presentation, where teams pitched their innovative concepts. **Round II, organized on 5th September 2024**, involved prototype development and evaluation. After comprehensive assessment based on novelty, feasibility, usability, and scalability, **30 teams were shortlisted** to represent the institute at the National Level Smart India Hackathon 2024.

A total of 43 teams with 258 students participated in the event, demonstrating collaborative effort from all branches with mandatory inclusion of girl participants. The hackathon provided students valuable exposure to real-world problem statements, teamwork culture, and hands-on learning with mentoring support.

The event was efficiently **coordinated under the guidance of Mr. Sagar U. More and Mr. Harshal S. Patil** (Internal Hackathon Faculty In-charge), ensuring smooth and successful execution.

Cyber Dhamaka Quiz and Challenge Fest

The Department of Computer Engineering successfully conducted, **The Cyber Dhamaka Quiz and Challenge Fest** was organized by the Cyber Security Cell.

As per AICTE guidelines, the main objective of the Cyber Security Cell is to raise awareness about cyber security among students.

The event was conducted in two rounds. The **first round** of the quiz was conducted on **20th September 2024**, and the **second round** was a CTF (Capture The Flag) challenge that was conducted on **27th September 2024**.

In the first round, 48 teams participated, from which 10 teams were shortlisted for the final round.

In the final round, 10 CTF challenges were given to each team. The team that solved the maximum number of challenges quickly was considered the winner. The **prize distribution** of the event was held on **10th October 2024**.

Nodevember 2.0

The Department of Computer Engineering at **R. C. Patel Institute of Technology, Shirpur**, under the Akatsuki Coding Club, **successfully organized a four-day hands-on workshop titled “Nodevember 2.0”** from 11th to 14th November 2024 for third-year Computer Engineering students. The workshop was designed to strengthen students’ backend development skills through industry-relevant **training in JavaScript, Node.js, Express.js, and MongoDB**, enabling them to build scalable server-side applications and modern web services.

The program followed a blended learning approach that combined concept-based sessions, live demonstrations, and guided hands-on practice. **Throughout the workshop, students gained practical exposure to developing secure RESTful APIs, integrating cloud-based databases, and deploying backend applications.** Interactive Menti quizzes conducted each day helped reinforce key concepts while encouraging participation and healthy competition among students.

A total of 120 students actively participated in the workshop, demonstrating strong curiosity, collaboration, and enthusiasm for backend development. Over the four days, students progressed from understanding client-server architecture and JavaScript fundamentals to working with advanced JavaScript concepts, Node.js, Express.js frameworks, and MongoDB database integration.

The final day focused on backend project development, where students built a Company Review System using the MVC architecture, implemented schemas and APIs, and tested endpoints using Postman. This practical experience allowed participants to apply the concepts learned during the workshop and develop a functional backend prototype.
