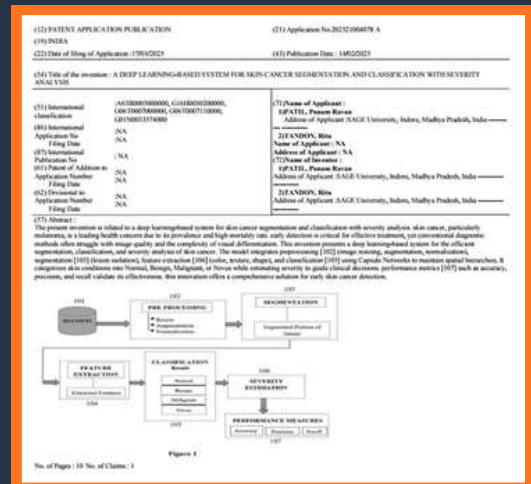

CodeCraze 2.0 by GDG RCPIT

The Department of Computer Engineering at R. C. Patel Institute of Technology, Shirpur, under GDG On Campus RCPIT, successfully organized CodeCraze 2.0 as part of Converges 2025. The event, designed as an Among Us-themed 24-hour hackathon, was conducted on 26–27 February 2025 with the objective of encouraging innovation, collaboration, and real-world problem-solving among students.

The hackathon was conducted in two stages. Round 1, an online idea presentation phase held from 12–23 February 2025, received an enthusiastic response with 113 teams submitting innovative project ideas, out of which 40 teams were shortlisted for the next round. Round 2, the offline prototype development round, was organized at the Computer Centre and Language Lab of the institute, where 160 participants (80 in-house and 80 external) worked intensively for 24 hours to transform their ideas into functional prototypes.

Teams were evaluated based on innovation (50%), prototype development (25%), and potential impact (25%). The event was assessed by an esteemed panel of judges including Dr. Suresh Kurumbanshi, Mr. Sagar Patil, Dr. Vinodkumar R. Patil, Dr. Priti S. Sanjekar, Dr. Manoj S. Ishi, and Dr. Sudarshan S. Sonawane, who appreciated the creativity and technical capabilities demonstrated by the participants.

The winners were awarded ₹5,000 for the first prize, ₹3,000 for the second prize, and ₹2,000 for the third prize. CodeCraze 2.0 provided students with a dynamic platform to collaborate, experiment with emerging technologies, and develop innovative solutions under time constraints, making it a memorable and impactful experience for all participants.

Muggles Mystery

The Department of Computer Engineering at R. C. Patel Institute of Technology, Shirpur, under E-Builders, successfully organized an exciting and interactive event titled “Muggles Mystery” as part of Converges 2025 on 27th and 28th February 2025. The event was designed to blend technical knowledge with strategic thinking and physical challenges, providing participants with a unique and engaging competitive experience.

The primary objective of the event was to strengthen students’ teamwork, communication, analytical thinking, and problem-solving abilities while creating an enjoyable learning environment. Several teams, each comprising four members, participated enthusiastically and competed across four creatively designed rounds.

The competition began with **Round 1 – Trust the Trail**, which tested coordination and teamwork through an obstacle navigation activity and a target-based scoring challenge. **Round 2 – Technical Evaluation** Round assessed participants’ technical competence through tasks involving code debugging, logic-based problem solving, and responsive webpage development using Bootstrap. **Round 3 – Who is the Spy?** focused on strategic reasoning, where participants analyzed clues and interactions to identify a hidden spy within their team. The event concluded with **Round 4 – Mystery Round**, which introduced unexpected tasks that required quick thinking and adaptability, ultimately determining the winning team.

“Muggles Mystery” successfully created a dynamic platform that combined technical skills, critical thinking, and teamwork, making the event both challenging and enjoyable for participants while contributing to their overall skill development.

The Animeverse

The **Department of Computer Engineering** at **R. C. Patel Institute of Technology, Shirpur**, under the **Akatsuki Coding Club**, successfully organized an exciting and intellectually engaging event titled **“The Animeverse”** as part of **Converges 2025**, the institute’s international tech fest. Conducted on **27th and 28th February 2025**, the event witnessed enthusiastic participation from **66 teams**, each comprising three to four members, who demonstrated their coding skills, creativity, and problem-solving abilities.

The event aimed to **strengthen students’ coding proficiency, logical reasoning, teamwork, and strategic thinking**, while incorporating a fun and competitive environment inspired by anime themes. The competition was conducted in multiple rounds designed to challenge participants in different aspects of technical and analytical thinking.

The **opening round, “Matrix Showdown,”** featured engaging activities such as **X-O Blitz**, a **life-sized Tic-Tac-Toe challenge** emphasizing speed and coordination, and **Binary Unlocked**, a memory-based binary conversion task supported by a custom digital system developed by the Akatsuki Coding Club. All participating teams advanced to the next stage.

The **second round, “CodeSprint 50,”** consisted of a **50-minute HackerRank coding challenge** comprising **50 questions** across **easy, medium, and hard** difficulty levels, testing participants’ coding accuracy, efficiency, and time management skills. Based on performance, the **top 28 teams** qualified for the final round.

The **concluding stage, “Chamber of Secrets,”** featured **15 progressive coding and logic-based levels**, where teams unlocked each stage using passwords generated from solved challenges. Participants could strategically utilize digital currency earned in earlier rounds to purchase hints or solutions, while a live leaderboard maintained a competitive atmosphere throughout the finale.

The React Cohort

The Department of Computer Engineering at R. C. Patel Institute of Technology, Shirpur, under the Akatsuki Coding Club, successfully organized a four-day technical workshop titled “The React Cohort” from 2nd to 5th April 2025. The workshop was conducted exclusively for second-year students with the objective of strengthening their skills in modern front-end development using React.js and Tailwind CSS, along with introducing them to component-based architecture and application deployment.

A total of 98 students actively participated in the workshop, which followed a project-based learning approach. During the sessions, participants collaboratively developed an “Online Project Selling Platform,” gaining hands-on experience with modern web development technologies.

The workshop began with an introduction to front-end development concepts and JavaScript fundamentals, including variables, functions, loops, asynchronous programming, and a basic overview of TypeScript. Students then explored React fundamentals such as components, JSX, props, and state management using useState, along with designing responsive user interfaces using Tailwind CSS.

As the workshop progressed, participants implemented advanced concepts including React Router, useEffect, conditional rendering, and API integration using Axios, enabling them to build dynamic and scalable web applications. On the final day, students learned deployment workflows, integrating their projects with GitHub and deploying them on Vercel, followed by project presentations and feedback sessions.

The workshop was inaugurated by Hon. Director Prof. Dr. J. B. Patil, with the support of Head of the Department Prof. Dr. R. B. Wagh, Department Coordinator Mr. M. M. Mahajan, and Faculty Coordinator Mr. S. U. More, whose guidance contributed to the successful execution of the program.
