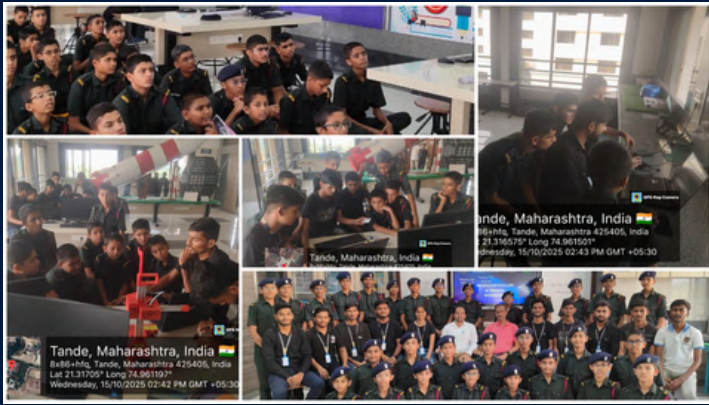
Parents–Teachers Meet 2025
